

# The Oberhaching Sports School Rules and Regulations

Oberhaching Sports School!*

Dear Guests,

The staff of The Oberhaching Sports School always strive to make your stay for all of our guests as pleasant as possible. The sports school should be an ideal location for training, further education and recreation. Therefore, we kindly ask you to take care of the equipment and facility, show consideration for others and respect the rules and regulations.

## 1. Guest Registration

- All guests must register at the reception. It is the responsibility of the trainer to ensure that all participants are properly registered and that they comply with the rules and regulations.
- The trainer is the first contact person for the General Manager in order to guarantee that everything runs smoothly. It is the trainer's duty to supervise the children of the group.

## 2. Facility and Equipment

All guests must observe the following when making use of the school and its equipment:

- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the whole school.
- Alcohol can only be served to adults age 18 and over.
- Alcohol must not be brought into the building for either storage or consumption.
- Footwear must always be worn in the facility due to risk of injury and athlete's foot. It is also not permitted to wear football boots in the building.
- It is not permitted for persons under the age of 18 to be alone in the swimming pool, sauna or gym.
- The rooms must be vacated on departure day by 10am at the latest.

## 3. Use of Sports Facilities

- The swimming pool is opened from 7.15am – 10pm and can only be used out with fixed booking times. The gym is opened for house guests from 7.15am – 10pm and can only be used out with fixed booking times. If reserved for a course, it is not possible for other course participants to use these facilities at the same time. You can find all booking times next to the swimming pool changing rooms and at the entrance to the gym. The reception staff will happily inform you of the existing reservations.
- The use of facilities of The Oberhaching Sports School is only permitted to house guests or by prior reservation in writing.
- The use of the sports facilities within the registered course times is only possible when the responsible course trainer is present.
- In addition to the rules and regulations, the respective rules of use of the facilities must also be observed. These are displayed in front of the respective facility.

#### 4. Accomodation

- All used facilities of the sports school must be left clean and tidy.
- Please save energy by avoiding dripping taps and unnecessary switched on lights or radios.
- On day of departure, please close all windows and doors.

#### 5. Electronic Devices

- The use of kettles, coffee machines and similar electrical appliances is not permitted.

#### 6. Guest Room Safe Deposit Box

- In every room there is a safe deposit box to store valuables.
- Please enter the code slowly and carefully to avoid the safe blocking automatically.
- Do not store food in the safe deposit box.

#### 7. W-LAN

- W-LAN passwords are available at the reception.

#### 8. Night Rest Period

- The night rest period in the sports school starts at 10pm and ends at 6.30am.
- Please observe the night rest period
- As and when required, the m/w/d employee of the security company Adjutant Service GmbH is authorised to intervene in the event of violation of the night rest period.

## 9. Meals

Meal times in the dining hall are as follows:

- Breakfast                    from 6.30am to 9.30am
  - Lunch                        from 11.30am to 2pm
  - Dinner                        from 5.30pm to 8pm
- In order to ensure that things run smoothly, please comply with the meal times stated in the course plan.
  - It is prohibited to take crockery and/or cutlery out of the dining hall. In addition to this, it is forbidden to bring food or drink into the dining hall.

## 10. Liability/Damages

- Each user is liable for all damages caused to the sports school by improper use.
- The Oberhaching Sports School is only liable for damages incurred by a participant of a course or a guest of another event when using the sports school if it can be proven to have acted intentionally or grossly negligently.
- If objects of the participants of a course or a guest of another event are lost or damaged, The Oberhaching Sports School is not liable for intent or gross negligence. Valuables and money must be stored in the locker in the cupboard provided for this purpose. In principle, no liability is assumed.
- Any damage must be reported immediately to the staff at the reception, even if it has not yet been determined by whom or in what way the damage was caused.
- The use of motorised vehicles upon The Oberhaching Sports School grounds by guests is not permitted. The designated parking spaces of The Oberhaching Sports School are intended exclusively for guests. No liability is assumed for damage to vehicles.

## 11. Key Cards and Departure

- Every guest receives a key card on arrival. You must take this with you when leaving the room. Please hand in the key card at the reception on the day of departure at the time stated in the course plan.
- In case of loss or damage to the key card, a fee of €10 will be charged.
